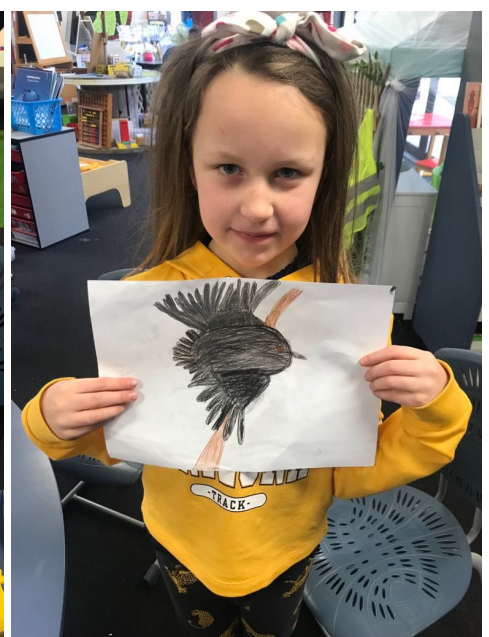


Art Trail Manawatu

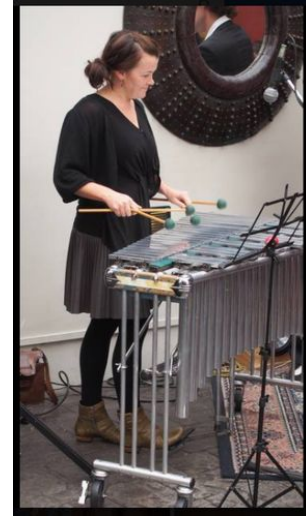
